Your phone service also has Speed Dial 8 and Speed Dial 100

To dial a number that you have set into your Speed dial 8 list, you would dial the number you associated with the speed dial followed by the pound sign (#).

#[00-99]

To dial a number that you have set into your Speed dial 100 list, you would dial the pound sign (#) followed by the two digit number you associated with the speed dial.
